



## TOBERMORY HARBOUR GUIDELINES

**As of the 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020, Tobermory Harbour Authority will begin to ease restrictions for visiting vessels.**

### VISITING BOATS

- For the remainder of the 2020 season - all visitors must book in advance of their visit.
- There is no pump out facility in Tobermory and this should be borne in mind particularly prior to the opening of the onshore facilities.
- Visitor numbers will be limited this year, this is to help with social distancing.
- When entering the harbour, please contact VHF 68 or the duty mobile: 07917 832497
- Please inform the harbour if you develop any COVID-19 symptoms. DO NOT come ashore.
- Abide by the current social distancing guidelines.
- Be mindful of other harbour users.
- Always wear a life jacket, stay safe.
- Be considerate to our community and local businesses.
- Please Sanitise your hands before entering or leaving the pontoons.
- Give way at the top of the bridges.
- Maintain good cough and sneeze etiquette.
- *PLEASE BE AWARE THAT LOCAL AND NATIONAL RESTRICTIONS COULD BE IMPOSED AT ANY TIME.*

### LOCAL LEISURE BOATS

- All Boats going to sea should inform the Coastguard or leave a passage plan with a relative or close friend
- Please check all safety equipment
- Wear a life jacket when on the pontoons or going out on your vessels.
- Ensure you have a VHF or a fully charged mobile phone.
- Respect social distancing guidelines.
- Wash your hands regularly.
- Stay at home if you are feeling unwell.

## **KAYAKS & CANOES**

- Before proceeding please inform the Coastguard or leave a passage plan with a relative or close friend
- Ensure you have a VHF or a fully charged mobile phone.
- Respect social distancing guidelines.

## **PEDESTRIANS**

- Social Distancing must be maintained at all times, gatherings are not permitted
- Keep left on the pontoons and maintain distance by stepping back onto a finger, or adjacent walkway, or platform
- Priority must be given to pedestrians coming up, coming ashore on all bridges

## **MAINTENANCE**

- The Beaches, the Slipway and the Boatpark will be open for essential maintenance subject to Social Distancing.
- We advise marking off your safe work area with ropes or similar
- Contact Tobermory Fishermen's Association for permission to use the Fishermen's Pier

## **COMMERCIAL VESSELS**

- Please contact Tobermory Harbour before entering the bay.
- If anyone has any symptoms that could be attributed to COVID 19 – they must inform the Harbour team, do not come ashore.
- Respect social distancing guidelines.
- Wash your hands regularly
