FROM THE 26th April 2021 NOTICE TO MARINERS NUMBER 2 IS NO LONGER IN FORCE AND SUPERCEDED BY THIS NOTICE.

As of the 26th April 2021, Tobermory Harbour Authority will begin to ease restrictions for visiting vessels.

- **The Scottish Government have advised that travellers to the Scottish Islands should take two lateral flow tests for COVID-19 prior to their visit. The first three days before travel and the second on the day of departure.**
- **For the 2021 Season – All visitors must book in advance of their visit.**

(We regret we cannot accept bookings out-with these times)
- **To ensure the safety of our visitors and help with social distancing, the number of boats and the number of visitors using our facilities will be limited.**

Tobermory Harbour Authority will continue to move with The Scottish Government guidelines, national and local restrictions which are being reviewed continually.
Please be advised that more stringent restrictions may return at short notice.

At all times, harbour users should:
